

## Kindergarten - 4th grade

\*New students are required to complete forms #1 & # 3

\*Returning students are required to complete forms #2 & #3

### 1. Entry Physical & Immunizations for Kindergarten & New Transfer Students

- *In accordance with New Jersey State Law, all students entering NJ schools are required to present documentation of having a **physical examination** (Universal Health Form) and receiving proper **immunizations** or a religious exemption.*
- *Updated Universal Health Form and immunization record or religious exemption must be given to the health office prior to the start of school and no later than 30 days of the student's start date.*
- Physicals must be completed within 365 days prior to beginning school. Otherwise, you will need to schedule a new exam and notify the school health office of the appointment date.
- All kindergarten students must receive DTap #5, IPV #4, and MMR #2 prior to the start of kindergarten.

### 2. Physical Forms

- All students must have a completed physical form on file in the health office. Please check if your child needs an updated physical form.
- *All students need to complete an updated Universal Health Form at least once during grades 2, 3, and 4.*
- It is highly encouraged all students have an updated Universal Health Form completed annually and sent to the health office.
- Physicals may only be performed once a year by your child's physician. If your child has had a physical within the past 365 days and does not have a completed physical form on file in the health office, please have your child's physician complete a Universal Health Form with information from the latest physical.

### 3. Student Health History Form

- All students need to complete the Student Health History Form annually. This form will help the health staff better care for your child. Our students' health and safety are our number one priority
