

PreK 3 & PreK 4

*New students are required to complete ALL forms

*Returning students are required to complete forms #2 & #3

1. Entry Physical & Immunizations for Pre-K

- *In accordance with New Jersey State Law, all students entering NJ schools are **required** to present documentation of having a **physical examination** (Universal Health Form) and receiving proper **immunizations** or a religious exemption.*
- *Completed Universal Health Form and immunization record or religious exemption must be given to the health office within 30 days of the student's start date.*
- Physicals must be completed within 365 days prior to beginning school. Otherwise, you will need to schedule a new exam and notify the school health office of the appointment date.
- Physicals may only be performed once a year by your child's physician. If your child has had a physical within the past 365 days and does not have a completed physical form on file in the health office, please have your child's physician complete a Universal Health Form with information from the latest physical.

2. PreK 3 & PreK 4 Influenza Vaccine

- *As per the NJ Department of Health: the **current seasonal flu vaccine is required every year for those children 6 months through 59 months of age.***
- Flu vaccines need to be given between the months of August/September (when the yearly vaccine is available) through December 31st of the current school year.
- **Students who have not received the flu vaccine by December 31st must be excluded** (not allowed to attend preschool) for the duration of the flu season (through March 31st), until they receive at least one dose of the flu vaccine or until they turn 60 months of age.
- **If you do not vaccinate your child** as per means of religious exemptions, please provide the school with a religious exemption letter stating this or **complete the attached Religious Exemption Form.**
- *Please send an updated immunization record to the Health Office once your child receives the Flu vaccine.*

3. Student Health History From

- All students need to complete the Student Health History Form annually. This form will help the health staff better care for your child. Our students' health and safety are our number one priority
